Each congregation will form a "Church Health Team" which will work towards the issues according to the data from the survey given. The "team" will be separate of the Council. They will work with a coach from outside the parish. Names were suggested for the "team". Applications for the administrative assistant position are being accepted until March 15. housed at Winnebago. A discussion was held with the Winnebago council about the need for help with preaching schedule. Options were presented with no action being taken.
